## CIRCULAR

It is hereby notified for information of members of the Bar, parties in person and all concerned that in view of the gigantic threat of **Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19**, which has already been declared as a 'global pandemic' by the World Health Organization (WHO), the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India has proclaimed complete lockdown in the entire country for a period of 21 days from 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2020, so as to prevent the spread of the epidemic across the country. Pursuant thereto, the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, issued an order dated 24<sup>th</sup> March, 2020, which, inter alia, provides that subject to certain exceptions, the Offices of the Central/State/Union Territory Governments, their Autonomous/Subordinate Offices and Corporations shall remain closed during the period of lockdown.

In view of the nation-wide lockdown declared by the Government of India, the functioning of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and the courts subordinate thereto has been directed to be suspended till 15<sup>th</sup> April, 2020. Hence, the Hon'ble Chairperson has directed that the functioning of the Principal Bench and all the Regional Benches of the Armed Forces Tribunal shall also remain suspended till 15<sup>th</sup> April, 2020.
