C I R C U L A R

As we are aware that the Government of India is taking various preventive measures to contain spread of COVID-19 and has issued several guidelines and advisories, from time to time, in this regard. We are also not oblivious of the fact that if the guidelines and advisories issued by the Government of India are not observed scrupulously and complete hygiene is not maintained, the situation will get worse.

In keeping with the said guidelines and observing restrictions as advised from time to time, the Armed Forces Tribunal will resume its functioning on 18th May, 2020 after the lockdown of more than one and a half month. However, it may not be feasible to resume normal Court work even at a reduced level unless certain conditions of personal hygiene, sanitation and various practices and precautions at personal and organizational level, mandated by the Government of India are met so that health and safety of personnel is not compromised.

In the event, when the Tribunal resumes its physical functioning on 18th May, 2020, if it is observed that complete hygiene is not maintained and the guidelines and/or advisories issued by the Government of India, from time to time, are not followed scrupulously, the Hon'ble Chairperson may be constrained to stop the physical functioning of the Court.
