Once the Petitioner has been already given a substantial relief in pursuance of the order passed by us on 7th October 2010 and fresh Medical Board has been convened and fresh Medical Board has found disability to the extent of 15% to 19% and the Government has already rounded up and granted him pension @ 50% and PPO has been issued, nothing remains in the petition.

However, learned counsel for the Petitioner insisted that Petitioner may be granted interest @ 12% p.a. on arrears. That cannot be given as at the time when initial order was passed no interest was granted. Therefore, now at this distant point of time no interest can be granted.

There is no merit in the petition and same is dismissed. No costs.
