Case is taken up at second call on the request of respondents.

This is an application for implementation of the judgment dated 25.03.2011. By way of the judgment, it was directed to reinstate the applicant in service, but despite reasonable time has been passed order has not been implemented. On previous date, learned officer appearing for the respondents, Maj. Rajni Sharma, D.V. Directorate, stated that against the judgment they intend to file SLP. Today, again on the same pretext adjournment is sought that SLP is under process and will be filed in due course. But, today also Maj. Rajni Sharma, learned officer for the respondents is not in a position to state any progress with regard to implementation of the judgment.

Vide order dated 31.10.2011 a cost of Rs.5,000/- was imposed on the respondents. Still the said cost has not been paid neither the judgment has been implemented. We have no alternative except to again impose cost and direct the respondents to show the status with regard to implementation of the judgment. Considering facts of the case, a cost of Rs.10,000/- is further imposed in addition to the cost imposed earlier. Learned counsel for the respondents requests six weeks time to comply with the judgment. Considering his request, time, as prayed for, is granted. We hope and trust that by the next date the order will be implemented.
