Mr. Rishabh Yadav, learned counsel appearing for respondent No. 3 and 4- Bank points out that the PPO sent by the department authorities was misplaced and not traceable in the head office of the Bank, as a result of which the Bank could not take action. It is submitted by him that PPO provided for the Bank will take action and ensure that benefit accruing to the applicant by virtue of the PPO is credited to the account of the applicant.

2. Taking note of the aforesaid, we direct the official respondent Nos. 1 to 2 representing by Shri Rajan Khosla to serve a copy the PPO on the counsel representing the Bank

within one week and on the same being done, the Bank shall ensure that the benefit accruing to the applicant is crediting to his Bank account within a period of two weeks and thereafter, report submitted to this Tribunal.

- 3. List the matter again on **12.07.2023**.
- 4. A copy of this order be provided DASTI to learned counsel for both the parties.
