Vide MA No. 5195/2023 filed under Sections 31(2) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Acat, 2007, the respondents seek grant of leave to appeal before the Hon'ble Supreme Court against the order passed by us on 22.11.2022 in OA 2656/2022, vide which OA filed by the appliant was dismissed. There being delay of 333 days, which is beyond the stipulated time limit, in filing the application for leave to appeal, MA No. 5196/2023 has also been filed seeking condonation of delay.
