## ORDER 23.11.2023

## MA 4940/2023

Through the medium of instant application, the applicant – Union of India seeks grant of leave to appeal under Sections 30 and 31 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007, before the Hon'ble Supreme Court for throwing challenge to the judgment dated 14th January, 2022 passed in the OA 713/2019.

- 2. We, however, we do not find any question of law, much less any question of law of general public importance involved in the matter to grant leave to appeal.
- 3. There being a delay of 260 days in filing the application for leave to appeal, MA 4941/2023 has also been filed for which there is no satisfactory explanation.

- 4. The instant application is thus dismissed both on merit and delay.
- 5. MA 4940/2023 and MA 4941/2023 thus stand disposed of.
