Vide MA 4254/2023 filed under Section 31 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act 2007, the respondents seek grant of leave to appeal before the Hon'ble Supreme Court against the order passed by us on 07.09.2022 in OA 245/2017. There being delay of 386 days, which is beyond the stipulated time limit, in filing the application for leave to appeal, MA 4253/2023 has also been filed seeking condonation of delay.

We have gone through our order dated 07.09.2022 passed in OA 245/2017. However, we do not find any point of law, much less any point of law of general public importance involved in the order, which warrants grant of leave to appeal. Accordingly, both the MAs are dismissed.
