Vide MA No. 4285/2023 filed under Sections 31 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007, the respondent seeks grant of leave to appeal before the Hon'ble Supreme Court against the order passed by us on 04.08.2023 in OA 629/2022. There being delay of 37 days, which is beyond the stipulated time limit, in filing the application for leave to appeal, MA No. 4286/2023 has also been filed seeking condonation of delay.
