As the grievances now made by the applicant with regard to the grant of less pension than his contemporaries is a different cause of action which cannot be adjudicated in the proceeding of under Section 29, finding the order passed by this Tribunal to have been implemented by issuance of the PPO.

- 2. In case, the applicant has any grievances with regard to disparity in the pension granted in comparison to his contemporaries, it gives a fresh cause of action to the applicant to be challenged in the proceeding of under Section 14 instead of in the proceeding of under Section 29.
- 3. In view of the aforesaid, the MA stands dismissed. However, If any grieveance still substinging, the applicant shall have the liberty to take legal recourse.

4. Accordinly, the MA stands disposed of.
