Learned counsel for the respondents has drawn our attention to para 5.4 & 5.5 of the counter affidavit filed by the respondents. In the said paragraph it has been admitted that para 14 & 15 of PRA (1961) and para 28 & 34 of PRA (2008) provides for grant of service pension to officers on completion of 15 years of qualifying service. However, it is mentioned that those provisions are applicable only to officers of Regular Army keeping in view the AFT's judgments in similar matters the case of the applicant has been referred to MoD to consider for grant of service pension to the applicant under Late Entrant Clause as an administrative decision. The MoD is directed to take a decision within three months, which must be brought on record by the next listing.
