Though vide order dated 06.04.2021 the cases mentioned have been tagged together, in as much as vide a catena of orders of this Tribunal, the Entitlement Rules for Casualty Pensionary Awards to Armed Forces Personnel 2008 have been deliberated upon, we consider it essential and appropriate that each of the

cases are heard separately and are directed to be listed separately for final hearing.

2. This is so, as we have already decided in a catena of orders of this Tribunal observing categorically to the effect that the spirit and principles of the verdicts of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Dharamvir Singh Vs. Union of India & Ors., Union of India & Anr. Vs. Rajbir Singh, Union of India & Ors. Vs. Manjeet Singh and Sukhvinder Singh Vs. Union of India and Ors.* form the fulcrum of the Entitlement Rules for the Casualty Pensionary Awards to Armed Forces Personnel 2008, and thus we direct that the proceedings of each case are heard separately.

3. Re-list the matter separately for final hearing on 08.02.2024.
