In this application, filed under Rule 25 of the Armed Forces Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 2008, read with Section 31 of the AFT Act, the relief sought pertains to the pending OA No. 2198/2024. Although the prayer clause seeks grant of leave to appeal the order passed in OA 2198/2024, a review of the statements made in Para 2 indicates that the applicant seeks the disposal of OA 2198/2024 in accordance with the order passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Tribunal on 03.07.2024 in OA 28/2024.

2. It is noted that on 03.07.2024, OA No. 28/2024, along with other related cases concerning the grant of Permanent Commission, was disposed of by a Coordinate Bench of this

Tribunal. Therefore, the primary relief sought in this application, although not explicitly stated in the prayer clause, is that OA No. 2198/2024 be disposed of in the same manner as the order passed in OA No. 28/2024.

3. Accordingly, the MA is allowed, and OA 2198/2024 is hereby disposed of in terms of the order passed on 03.07.2024 in OA No. 28/2024.

4. Learned counsel further prays for grant of leave to appeal to impugn the order passed in OA 2198/2024.

5. We find no point of law much less any point of law of general public importance for grant of leave to appeal. Accordingly the prayer for grant of leave to appeal is dismissed.
