In OA 593/2017 after hearing all concerned, on 19.06.2020, a Bench of this Tribunal had passed an order allowing the benefit of war injury pension to the applicant directing the respondents to pay war injury element along with arrears with effect from three years prior to the date of filing of the OA, i.e., 03.04.2017.

2. After order was passed on 19.06.2020, the matter was taken up for implementation and finally on 08.02.2020, the Record Office forwarded a communication to the Chief Manager, Central Bank of India, CPFC, 2nd Floor MMO Bldg MG Road, Fort Mumbai- 400023 that the claim of the applicant has been settled. Thereafter, the PCDA (P), Allahabad, issued a PPO bearing No.153197600662 dated 24.09.2021 and it was directed that the amount be paid to the applicant in accordance with the requirement of law. A copy of this communication

was forwarded to the Branch Manager, Central Bank of India, Dujana Jhajjar Haryana and to the applicant.

3. The applicant has filed all the required documents and it is the grievance of the applicant that even though more than a year has passed after the issuance of the PPO, the Bank in question has not taken any action and the amount has not been credited to his account.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid, notice be issued by the office to the Chief Manager, Central Bank of India, CPFC, 2nd Floor MMO Bldg MG Road Fort Mumbai- 400023 and the Branch Manager, Central Bank of India, Dujana Jhajjar Haryana. The Principal Registrar of this Tribunal is directed to forward a copy of this order, the communication dated 08.02.2022 and a copy of the PPO to the concerned officers of the Bank along with a copy of this order,

5. The concerned Bank officer is directed to remain present before this Tribunal on the next date of hearing along with all records and indicate as to what action was taken by them for crediting the amount in the applicant's account and, if there has been any delay, the reason for the delay.

6. List the matter on **20th November, 2023**.

7. A copy of this order be provided '*DASTI*' to learned counsel for both the parties.
