Mr. Kadian when during the course of arguments relied upon letter dated 24.05.1951 issued by the MoD to derive the benefit for counting of service of the husband of the applicant as doubled for the purpose of grant of mustering out pension/gratuity, on being asked specifically, whether the husband of the applicant who was discharged on 31.03.1951 after joining Kota Infantry on 03.06.1941 and remained there till 04.11.2006, was in possession of any document or service medal showing his deployment in field service, he fairly stated that he has not got any instructions from the applicant in this regard although, in the OA, the applicant has averred that her husband went outside the country during World War II. He states that he may be given some more time to verify this fact. Four weeks' time is granted for the same.

It is made clear to Mr. Kadian if he wants to place any other document in support of the claim of the applicant, he may lay motion for the same within two weeks' time by providing a copy of the same to learned counsel for the respondents in advance enabling them to respond to the same before the next date of hearing.
