Some documents have been produced on behalf of the respondents pursuant to proceedings dated 01.11.2023. However, the said documents relate only to the year 2011.

2. Without any observations on the merits and demerits of the prayers made in the present OA, in view of the submission that have been made on behalf of the applicant, placing reliance on the current evaluation in Part-II in the Summary and Opinion dated 26.04.2018 qua the applicant with the case summary therein to the effect:-

“CASE SUMMARY: This 52 years old serving sailor, a reformed smoker with no genetic pre loading, found to have LBBB on ECG during AME in Apr 2011. He underwent CAG in APR 2011 and found to have normal Epicardial coronaries. He reported in August 2013 with complaints of Dyspnoea on exertion (NYHA class-II) and 2D ECHO in showed LV. Dysfunction (EF-35%) suggestive of DCM. He underwent cardiac resynchronization- therapy- P (CRT-T) on 13 Aug 13.

Again he reported in Apr 2016 with complaint of intermittent chest pain with breathlessness on exertion. On evaluation his ECG revealed ventricular paced RHYTHM 2D ECHO revealed LVEF= 50% with Dilated cardiomyopathy and Dyslipidemia. Presently he has reported for RMB & he is asymptomatic. His 2D ECHO shows Dilated LV with LVEF=50%.”

to submit to the effect that the applicant had undergone cardiac resynchronization therapy-P(CRT-T) on 13.08.2013 and had also reported with complaint of intermittent chest pain with breathlessness on exertion in April, 2016 with the further submissions made on behalf of the applicant that the applicant suffered from LBBB, Dilated Cardiomyopathy S/P Cardiac Resynchronization Therapy-P(CRT-P), ICD No I 44.7, I 42.0, the records of the Re-categorization boards for the years 2012 onwards till discharge be produced by the respondents in original within a period of four weeks.

Re- list the matter on 05.01.2024
