In spite of the detailed order passed on 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2023 in the backdrop of the remand order by the Hon'ble Supreme Court on 09.03.2017, the respondents have not filed the counter affidavit.

2. The OA is pending since 2009. Though, it was decided finally by this Tribunal vide orders passed on 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> June, 2010, however, on a remand order dated 09.03.2017 made by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the matter has to be re-heard. As the issue is pending since long and the Hon'ble Supreme Court has directed for deciding the issue in a time bound manner, as a matter of last indulgence, we grant four

weeks' further time to the respondents to file the additional affidavit as directed on 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2023, failing which we shall proceed in the matter without granting any further time.
