Having heard learned counsel for the parties we find that in the order passed by the Second Appellate Authority on 27th September, 2022 the applicant is shown as a smoker and a consumer of alcohol and it is held that the Primary Hypertension is not attributable to nor aggravated by military service because of these reasons.

2. However, this finding of the Second Appellate Authority is not supported by any medical document available on record. Respondents are directed to produce the medical documents based on which the finding of Second Appellate Authority has been recorded. Four weeks' time is granted for the same.
