The applicant vide the present OA makes the following prayers:-

*“(a) To direct the Respondents to restore the commuted portion of the pension (Amount of Rs. 16167/- to be restored) w.e.f. 11.01.2025.*

*(b) To direct the respondents to pay the arrears that had occurred due to non-restoration of commutation of pension.*

*(c) To direct the respondents to pay 12% interest on the arrears accrued to the Applicant.*

*(d) To pass any other appropriate order or relief which this Hon'ble Tribunal deems fit and proper anytime during the proceedings of this case.”*

2. Along with the same is also a prayer seeking grant of interim relief to the effect:-

*“To direct the respondents to halt the recovery of the commuted amount of pension from the applicant's pension. The recovery of the commuted pension was supposed to be halted in June 2024 on the completion of 11 years and 6*

*months. The applicant prays for an interim relief to stop the recovery from the Applicant's pension as he same is causing huge financial losses to the applicant and the balance of convenience is in his favor."*

3. At this stage, learned counsel present on behalf of the applicant submits that in view of the order of the Hon'ble High Court of Punjab and Haryana dated 27.11.2024 in CWP 9426/2023, she seeks to withdraw the present OA with a liberty to seek redressal, if any, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the said submission, OA 4897/2024 is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty granted as prayed.
