Learned counsel for the applicant makes a complaint that after the pension was released arrears paid and credited to the applicant's bank account, the CPPC of the Bank is not permitting the applicant to utilize the amount credited to his account and has seized his account. If that be so, this grievance gives rise to a separate cause of action and the applicant should file an affidavit indicating all these facts.

2. We grant two weeks' time to learned counsel for the applicant to file the affidavit to bring all subsequent grievances on record.
