The respondents have filed MA 371/2024 praying for grant of leave for impugning the orders dated 31.01.2023 to the Hon'ble Supreme Court in terms of Section 30 & 31 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007. There being a delay of 312 days. MA 372/2024 has also been filed seeking condonation in filing MA 371/2024.

2. Having heard learned counsel for the applicant, we find no point of law much less any point of law of general public importance involved in the matter. There is also no satisfactory explanation for the delay of 312 days. Hence the pryaer for leave to appeal is declined both on the grounds of merit and delay.
