A complaint is made by learned counsel for the applicant to say that in respect of the order passed by the Tribunal on 1st November, 2023, the applicant had been visiting the branch of the bank in question namely, State Bank of India, Branch Lakhana, Distt- Etawah, Uttar Pradesh. It is pointed out by him that in spite of repeated requests made, the bank is not crediting the amount to the account of the applicant neither disbursing the amount to the applicant in accordance to the PPO bearing No. 194202202105 issued on 16th December, 2022.

2. Keeping in view the aforesaid, issue notice to the Branch Manager, State Bank of India, Lakhana, Etawah,

UP-2016127 and the Chief Manager, State Bank of India, CPPC, 4 Kutchery Road Allahabad, UP-211002 along with a copy of this order directing them to comply with the directions issued and ensure that the amount, as indicated in the PPO, is credited within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and report be submitted to the Principal Registrar, Armed Forces Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi.

3. List again on 19th January, 2024. In case no action as directed hereinabove is taken by the Branch Manager, the Principal Registrar is directed to issue a bailable warrant to the tune of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five thousand only) for arrest and appearance of the Branch Manager before this Tribunal on the date fixed by the Principal Registrar.

4. Let a copy of this order be provided *DASTI* to learned counsel for the parties.
