This application has been filed seeking execution of an order passed in OA 1667/2023 initially on 6<sup>th</sup> July, 2023 and modified vide order passed on 6<sup>th</sup> November, 2023 in RA 53/2023. The modified order passed in RA 53/2023 reads as under:-

“4. In our considered view, there is necessity for reviewing the order. Respondents may simply communicate to the applicant in the manner in which pay fixation has been done and according to the respondents the same being the beneficial option, it should be intimated to the applicant so that if still dissatisfied the applicant may proceed in accordance with law.

5. In case the applicant is not entitled to the benefits for any reason other than the above whatsoever the respondents are free to discuss the same and communicate to the applicant by a speaking order.

6. With the aforesaid observations, finding no case for review, the RA is dismissed.”

2. Now today when the matter is taken up, Mr. Anil Gautam, Sr. CGSC appearing for the respondents submits that in pursuance to the order passed by this Tribunal on 6<sup>th</sup> November, 2023, the claim of the applicant for his entitlement with regard to grant of benefits was examined by the respondents and by recording various reasons a detailed speaking order has been passed on 24<sup>th</sup> April, 2024 stating as to how the benefits can be granted to the applicant and that being so, we dispose of the application with a liberty to the applicant, if any grievance still subsisting he may proceed in the matter in accordance with law.

3. Accordingly, granting aforesaid liberty, the application stands disposed of.
