Vide order passed on 28<sup>th</sup> August, 2023 after the PPO was issued by the competent authority granting benefit to the applicant we had directed the Branch Manager, State Bank of India, Beri, Rohtak and the Chief Manager, State Bank of India, CPPC, Panchkula to comply with the indications made in the PPO and credit the amount as indicated in the PPO to the account of the applicant within two weeks and submit a report before the Principal Registrar.

2. Notice was issued to the Branch manager, State Bank of India, Beri, Rohtak, Haryana and Chief Manager, CPPC, State Bank of India, Panchkula, Haryana on 14<sup>th</sup> September, 2023 and was served on 20<sup>th</sup> September, 2023 and 18<sup>th</sup> September, 2023 respectively. No compliance report has been filed even after

issuance of notice. Therefore, matter was placed before us on 10<sup>th</sup> November, 2023 in chamber by the Principal Registrar, on which date we passed an order directing Principal Registrar to forward a copy of this order and direct the Branch Manager to remain present before this Tribunal on 18.12.2023 along with his explanation.

3. Notice was again issued by the office to the Branch Manager, on 16<sup>th</sup> November, 2023 which was served on Bank on 22<sup>nd</sup> November, 2023. Thereafter, the Bank Manager, State Bank of India, Beri, Rohtak, Haryana vide letter dated 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2023 has issued a communication to the PCDA (Prayagraj) wherein he has indicated that after receipt of the order from the Armed Forces Tribunal on 16<sup>th</sup> November, 2023 in matter of payment of PPO, details were sent to the CPPC Panchkula for necessary action. However, the CPPC unit has indicated that they have not received the PPO and issued a non-payment certificate as the pension account of the applicant has been migrated to the SPARSH Allahabad and now it is for the PCDA (P) to take further action in the matter, a copy of this letter is forwarded to the Principal Registrar for information.

4. Taking note of the aforesaid, we direct for issuance of notice to the PCDA (P) along with a copy of this order and

the copy of the letter dated 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2023 directing the competent authority to take action in the matter within two weeks from the date of receipt of this order and ensure the entire amount due to the applicant as per the PPO is credited to his account and a report be submitted to the Tribunal and may involve learned counsel for the respondents for necessary compliance.

5. List again on 11<sup>th</sup> January, 2024.

6. Let a copy of this order be provided *DASTI* to learned counsel for the parties.
