## MA 1276/2017

- 1. This is an application for condonation of delay under Section 5 of the Limitation Act read with Section 22 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007. There is delay of 93 days in filing the present Original Application. The delay of 93 days is condoned as sufficient cause is shown.

## OA 1694/2017

- This is an application under Section 14 of the Armed Forces Tribunal act, 2007 for grant of disability pension. However, he was denied the disability pension on account of the fact that the applicant had resigned from the military service. It had been stated by the learned counsel that despite the resignation having been given by the applicant he is entitled to the disability pension. He further states that he wants to cite certain judgmentsof the Hon'ble Supreme Court as well as of the High Court and would cite the same on the next date of hearing.
