Even though the applicant has filed an application for early hearing, we find from the records that the respondents have filed their counter affidavit in the year 2019 and accepted that the applicant, Master Gaurav, is entitled to 100% pension.

2. Today, a communication made on 10.04.2019 is brought to our notice by the respondents, wherein certain formalities are required to be completed by the applicant for the purpose of granting him the benefit of pension. However, Shri Gupta, learned counsel for the applicant, points out that nothing has been communicated to the applicant and he is not aware of the formalities which are to be completed.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid, we issue the following directions :

‘The respondents shall communicate to the applicant the formalities to be completed by the applicant within a period of 15 days from today and on the same being done, the applicant shall ensure that all the formalities are completed within a period of one month and the respondents shall ensure that all the benefits that accrue to the applicant are paid within a period of one month from the date of compliance made by the applicant.’
