Inspite of the fact that the Hon'ble Supreme Court has decided the issue about a year back i.e. on 27.11.2019, respondents have not taken any action for implementing the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and the Tribunal and even though we had granted time on 05.10.2020, today, we are informed that after obtaining opinion from the counsel for the Union of India, namely, Additional Solicitor General, the department proposes to file a review application before the Hon'ble Supreme Court and four weeks' time is sought for the same.

As a matter of last indulgence, we grant four weeks' time from today to the respondents to seek instructions with a clear stipulation that in case no action is taken before the next date, we may proceed to take coercive action in the

matter as the applicant has already retired and now, in our considered view, after the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court, nothing survives in the matter and the benefit claimed for in the Original Application should be granted.
