The applicant vide the present OA makes the following prayers :-

- a) *Direct respondents to condone the deficiency/ short fall of 07 months and 16 days of service to make the applicant eligible for grant of service pension from Defence Security Corps. If the Respondent on verification of Records find a different figure for number of days required to be condoned then the Respondent be directed to accord the required condonation as long as it is less than one year.*
- b) *Direct respondents to grant service pension from Defence Security Cops including retiral and consequential benefits with effect from the date of discharge i.e. from 01.02.2024 and to pay the due arrears with interest @ 12% per annum till final payment is made.*
- c) *Any other relief which the Hon'ble Tribunal may deem fit and proper in the fact and circumstances of the case with cost against the respondents.*

Notice thereof is issued and accepted on behalf of the respondents. The pleadings in the matter are directed to be completed within a period of three months by either side, and the matter be listed before the Principal Registrar for completion of

pleadings on **05.04.2024** and placed before the Bench thereafter on **01.10.2024**.

In view of the pendency of the said issue before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in WP (C) 2126/2024 and WP (C) 2863/2024 where a similar issue in relation to condonation of shortfall of DSC service of less than a year is involved, the Registry is directed to re-notify the matter after disposal of the said writs by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi.
