We find that orders passed by this Tribunal are not being implemented inspite of repeated opportunities having been granted to the respondents.

2. This is a case where on 18<sup>th</sup> May, 2023 the OA 410/2023 was allowed and even then the order has not been implemented, thereafter, on 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2023 RA 51/2023 was filed by the respondents and on 6<sup>th</sup> November, 2023 the same was dismissed by this Tribunal.

3. On 3<sup>rd</sup> October, 2023 execution application was filed and on 9<sup>th</sup> October, 2023, 18<sup>th</sup> December, 2023 and 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2024 time was granted to the respondents

to comply with the order passed by this Tribunal, but till today nothing has been done.

4. We are observing that the respondents are not taking us seriously and large number of applications for execution are piling up with us.

5. In view of the aforesaid, we direct Air Officer-in-Charge Personnel (AOP) of the Air Force Headquarter, to be present with the records and explain as to why the orders are not being implemented even after taking several opportunities.

6. List the matter on **29<sup>th</sup> April, 2024**.
