*“5) That the deponent was promoted to the substantive rank of Colonel vide HQ 25 Artillery Brigade Part II order no. 0002/2017 w.e.f. 01-02-2005 but the deponent had not received any financial benefits that accrued as a result of above Part II order as applicable to the rank of Colonel for the said period of active service as well as for the period of post retirement including fixation of pay and allowance as per Central Pay Commissions as applicable.”*

2. On behalf of the respondents have been submitted a document dated 03.04.2024 to submit however to the effect that even the arrears of pay and allowances for the period 01.02.2005

3. Counsel for the applicant however submit that no such payment has been made. The PCDA (P) is directed to explain the breakup of the payments made to the applicant vide an affidavit of the authorized representative of the respondents.
