It is pointed out by the learned counsel for the applicant that despite the intervention of this Court, the applicant's son has not yet been admitted to the Army Hospital (R&R). It is stated that the concerned authority at the Army Hospital (R&R) has stated that only on basis of the judicial order they will admit the applicant's son in the hospital for treatment.

2. From perusal of the previous orders, it is observed that on 04.08.2025, the Bench had directed the Army Hospital (R&R) to evaluate the medical condition of the applicant's son and provide treatment for the disease (CKD) and time was granted to the respondents to file their counter affidavit.

3. A subsequent order was passed on 14.11.2025 wherein it was mentioned that the patient could not be admitted as he was

categorized as a non-entitled patient. Though, the hospital was ready to advise the applicant to admit his son(as a non-entitled patient) but the same was refused by the applicant. However, on 14.11.2025 the applicant has agreed to admit his son as a non-entitled patient and deposit the initial requisite payment. Both these orders were directed to be issued *DASTI* to both the parties. Despite this, it has been informed to us today that the applicant's son has still not been admitted to the R&R Army Hospital.

4. The present order, along with the orders dated 04.08.2025 and 14.011.2025, shall be served as *DASTI* on the Commandant R&R Army Hospital, to ensure that the treatment of the applicant's son is commenced immediately.

5. Arguments are heard.
