2. Seeking payment of disability pension @ 50% for the ailment in question based on the recommendation of the RMB, applicant has invoked the jurisdiction of this Tribunal under Section 14 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007 and in Para 2 of the counter affidavit along with the PPO (Annexure R-1 and 2), the respondents make the following statement:-

“2. It is submitted that Disability Element @ 50% has already been granted to the applicant notified vide PCDA Allahabad PPO No 194201902087-

0601, Copy of the same is annexed herewith as Annexure R-1. The same has been forwarded to Stated Bank of India CPCC for making payment of pension and other terminal benefits to the pensioner with a copy to the individual and advised him to report his bank alongwith PPO vide DSC Records letter No NER/4552694F/61/LC-3 dated 04 Jul 2022 Copy of the same is annexed herewith as Annexure R-2.”

3. In view of the above, *prima facie* it seems that the application is rendered infructuous. However, learned counsel for the applicant wants to seek instructions in the matter. Four weeks' time is granted for the same.
