It has come on record that the PPO has been issued on 1<sup>st</sup> May, 2023 and on 30<sup>th</sup> August, 2024 an oral statement was made by the counsel for the applicant to say that the amount accruing to the applicant by virtue of the PPO has not been credited to his account. Even though on 30<sup>th</sup> August, 2024 we had indicated that we shall take coercive action in the matter but we can take judicial notice of the fact that in a case we have called PCDA, SPARSH (Prayagraj) for personal appearance and the said officer has personally appeared in Court and submitted that even after issuance of PPO and grant of benefits oral submissions have been made by the counsel for the applicant that the benefits

have not been credited to the applicant's account and it was found to be a false statement.

2. Taking note of the aforesaid, we direct the applicant to make his submission with regard to amount not being credited to his account on his personal affidavit. Only on receipt of the affidavit of the applicant, the submission would be considered and decision be taken. Four weeks' time is granted to the applicant to file his personal affidavit indicating these facts.
