The applicant vide the present application MA 2164/2024 instituted on 14.05.2024 seeks implementation of the order dated 02.01.2024 in OA 943/2019 whereby vide para 11 thereof, it was directed to the effect :-

*“11. Under the circumstances, the OA 943/2019 is partly allowed and the applicant is to be held entitled to the grant of the disability element of pension qua the disability of Anterior Wedge Compression Fracture C-5 assessed @20% for life which is directed to be broad banded to 50% for life in terms of the verdict of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Union of India vs. Ram Avtar decided on 10.12.2014 in Civil Appeal No. 418/2012 with effect from the date of his discharge from the Indian Air Force and the respondents are directed to issue the corrigendum PPO with directions to the respondents to pay the arrears within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, failing which, the respondents would be liable to pay interest @6% p.a. on the arrears due from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.”*

The records of the OA 943/2019 indicate that the prayer made on behalf of the respondents seeking leave to appeal against the said order has been expressly declined in terms of Section 31(1) of the AFT Act, 2007. Whilst accepting notice of the application, learned counsel for the respondents seek six weeks time to submit the compliance report.

The matter be re-notified for hearing on **07.08.2024**.
