Seeking modification of an order passed in OA 88/2023 in the matter of pay fixation of the applicant on his exercising the most beneficial option to the rank of Cpl under 6<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission, the Tribunal had granted relief to the applicant vide order passed on 17.11.2023. Now by filing MA 2783/24 the respondents seek modification of the said order on the grounds detailed in Para 5 of the application which reads as under:

*“5. That this Hon’ble Tribunal has directed to review the pay fixed of the Applicant on promotion to the rank of Cpl under the 6<sup>th</sup> CPC. However, pay fixation with most beneficial option to the rank of Cpl under 6<sup>th</sup> CPC can only processed once the pay of the Applicant is re-fixed from the date of promotion to the rank of LAC as per most beneficial option.*

2. However, no document in support of the same indicating the pay fixation of the applicant as indicated in the aforesaid para and the amount received by him on such pay fixation to indicate

as to how it is more beneficial to the applicant has been filed by the respondents.

3. The respondents are directed to file the orders and the chart indicating the pay fixation and the benefit which was granted to the applicant in the manner of pay fixation by the aforesaid process as indicated in Para 5.

4. Re-list both the application MA 2230/2024 and MA 2783/2024 on **04.10.2024**.

5. A copy of this order be provided DASTI to learned counsel for both the parties.
