The applicant has filed this execution application seeking implementation of the order passed on 12.02.2024 in OA No. 494/2024. After going through the Court's order sheet it came to know that on the very first day when the case was listed for admission without notice to the respondents the OA was allowed.

2. Today when the matter is taken up for consideration, it is pointed out by Shri Pramod Kumar, learned counsel for the respondents that the pleadings made by the applicant in the aforesaid OA and in the order passed on 12.02.2024 by this Tribunal, the date of promotion of the applicant to the post of LAC shown as "01.02.2006" whereas as per records for

implementing the order on scrutiny, it is found that the correct date of promotion is “01.10.2006”.

3. Therefore, learned counsel for the respondents seeks correction of the date of promotion of the applicant to the rank of **LAC** and prays for some time to comply with the order passed by this Tribunal. Prayer allowed.

4. Considering the same to be correct and taking note of the fact that the OA was allowed on the first date without issuance of notice to the respondents and the respondents did not have any opportunity to give their say in the matter. We direct that the date of promotion of the applicant to the rank of **LAC** be treated as “01.10.2006” in place of “01.02.2006” wherever it appears in the order dated 12.02.2024 and shall form part of the said order. Accordingly, further action should be made for conferring the benefits of pay fixation to the applicant and respondents are directed to complete this process and submit a compliance report to this Tribunal within a period of six weeks.

5. List the matter again on **24.10.2024**.
