Invoking the jurisdiction of this Tribunal under Section 14 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act 2007, the applicant has prayed for grant of pay fixation in the most beneficial option.

2. On notice being issued, the respondents have undertaken fixation of pay of the applicant and issued PPO granting benefits to him. When the matter was taken up on the last date, it was informed by the applicant that even though the PPO had been issued but the amount has not been credited to his bank account and the arrears have also not been paid. Today, the respondents have produced before us a communication dated 20<sup>th</sup> November, 2024 issued by the Records Office, Mahar Regiment along with pay slip of the applicant indicating payment of benefits to the applicant and crediting a sum of Rs. 1,73,875/- to his account along with pay for the month of November, 2023.

3. Taking note of the aforesaid, we find nothing further to be done in the matter. As the prayer of the applicant having been granted by the respondents, the OA has rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
