On behalf of the respondents, learned counsel submits that the respondents intend to assail the order dated 31.07.2023 in OA 2206/2019 by filing a writ petition. Vide a separate order dated 31.07.2023 on the records of OA 2206/2019, the prayer made by the respondents seeking grant of leave to appeal against the said order in terms of Section 31(1) of the AFT Act, 2007, has been expressly declined. Vide orders dated 13.03.2024 and 04.01.2024, the respondents were granted six weeks time, and four weeks' time respectively, to submit the compliance report of compliance of directions dated 31.07.2023 in OA 2206/2019.

3. In view thereof, in the event of there being no stay order of the operation of the order dated 31.07.2023 in OA 2206/2019, being placed on the record by the respondents for the next date of

hearing, the respondents shall place on record the affidavit for compliance of the said directions on the next date of hearing along with a demand draft for payment of costs of a sum of Rs. 50,000/- in the name of the applicant.

4. The matter be re-notified for hearing on 10.07.2024.
