In compliance with the order passed by this Tribunal in OA No.405/2021, the Competent Authority has examined the mercy petition filed by the applicant. In accordance with the powers vested in the Competent Authority under Regulation 102(a) of the Pension Regulations for the Air Force, 1961, read in conjunction with the relevant provisions of the Government of India, the Competent Authority has granted 90% Service Pension and 90% Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity (DCRG) to the applicant.

2. This decision has been duly approved by the Ministry of Defence and the applicant has been directed to submit certain documents necessary for processing his claim as communicated vide letter dated 08.07.2025.

3. The applicant shall submit the requisite documents as called for and upon such submission the respondents shall process the claim and release the admissible benefits to the applicant within six weeks from the date of receipt of the documents.
