As far as grant of MACP benefits are concerned, the applicant who appears in person indicates to us that even though he has received arrears and his pension has also been increased but the calculation based on which the amount has been paid is not given to him and, therefore, he has reasons to believe that the arrears have not been calculated correctly in accordance to the requirement of the rules. That being so, respondents are directed to file compliance on affidavit and also calculations based on which the benefits have been granted to the applicant so that if the applicant has any objection he could raise it before us and same is sorted out.

Four weeks' time granted to the respondents to file the clarificatory affidavit as directed hereinabove.

2. List the matter again on 26<sup>th</sup> March, 2025.
