Issue notice to the respondents.

Applicant claims an interim relief to the effect that he be granted study leave provisionally and permitted to join the course at (AFMC), Pune. This prayer is opposed too by the respondents primarily on the ground that the applicant has been awarded 'Severe Reproof' operative for 12 months from 22.05.2025 to 21.05.2026 and they invites our attention to policies and AFO to indicate that during the operative period of 'Reproof' or 'Severe Displeasure' the applicant can not be permitted to go on study leave.

That apart, preliminary objection is also raised to say that study leave is a kind of a leave and in view of the provisions of exclusion clause in Section 3 sub clause (iii) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, leave of any kind can not be

subjected to adjudicatory jurisdiction of this Tribunal under the Armed Forces Tribunal Act of 2007.

In view of the above, no case is made out for grant of any interim relief, the prayer for grant of interim relief stands rejected.

List the matter on **13.08.2025** to enable the respondents to raise appropriate objections.
