In pursuance to the order passed by this Tribunal on 06.02.2024 on instructions received by the OIC, Legal Cell vide communication dated 15.03.2025, we are informed that the Board of Officers were detailed under the aegis of The Sikh LI Regimental Centre to examine and recommend PMR on compassionate ground to most deserving clerks. The following parameters have been indicated which were considered:-

“The Board of Officers considered the following parameters:-

- (a) Weightage to persons who are in waiting for long time.
- (b) Weightage to supporting documents with discharge applications duly checked/verified/vetted by military medical authority.

- (c) Scrutiny of service, posting, discipline and medical category profile of all persons.”

And in Para 4 it is stated that in the case of recommended candidates, PMR has been granted, however, in the case of the applicant it is not granted.

2. We direct the respondents to file an additional affidavit indicating the number of candidates considered for grant of PMR, the criteria laid down and the reasons for grant of PMR to certain candidates and rejection of the claim of the case of the applicant by the Board. The reasons on which the applicant's case was rejected be indicated in the additional affidavit. Three weeks' time is granted for the same.

3. List the matter again on 21st April, 2025 under the same heading.

4. Let a copy of this order be provided *DASTI* to learned counsel for the parties.
