From the documents filed by the respondents, it is clear that all benefits accruing to the applicant by virtue of the order passed on 04.09.2023 in OA 1164/2023 have been paid to the applicant after Government Sanction issued on 12.08.2024. A communication available on record dt 06.12.2024 indicates that a sum of Rs. 9,54,614/- has been credited to the petitioner's bank account as detailed in para 2 of the aforesaid communication. However, the applicant's counsel on instructions makes an oral complaint that service arrears have been paid to the applicant but the post retiral benefits have not been conferred. If that being so the applicant shall file a detailed affidavit indicating what are the claim still subsisting and which are not been paid. However, the learned counsel for the respondents stated that the applicant is still in service and therefore, for the present we found that there is some confusion with regard to the post retiral benefit. Taking

note of the compliance submitted by the respondents, we dispose of the matter with liberty to the applicant to claim any further benefit in case if he has any by submitting a representation to the Competent Authority and on the same being done, the Competent Authority to examine the claim of the applicant and decide it in accordance with law within four weeks of its submission, with the aforesaid the application stands disposed of.
