On behalf of the respondents the pension slip for September 2024 with commutation of pension details and OROP arrears break-up details have been submitted along with a copy of the PPO No. 501201600076 dated 26.04.2024.

2. Time is sought both on behalf of the respondents and the applicant to verify the aspect of compliance of direction dated 27.02.2023 in OA 1606/2019 whereby vide Para 10 thereof it was directed to the effect:-

10. The respondents are thus, directed to:

(a) grant one notional increment to the applicant for the period 1st July, 2016 to 30th June, 2017, as he has completed one full year of service, for the purpose of pensionary benefits and not for any other purpose;

(b) issue fresh corrigendum PPO to the applicant accordingly subject to his fulfilling other conditions which are applicable;

(c) obtain an undertaking from the applicant while extending such benefits that in case the Hon'ble Supreme Court takes a different view in the Civil Appeal arising

*out of SLP (Civil) No. 4722/2021, he would
refund the entire benefits with interest;*

*(d) give effect to this order within a period of four
months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this
order. The arrears that become due shall be paid without
interest.”*

3. The matter be re-notified for hearing on **20.12.2024**.
