In paragraphs 5,6,7, 8, 9 and 10 of the counter affidavit, the respondents have clearly indicated that the benefits of transfer grant and leave encashment have already been granted to applicant as is evident from the documents annexed as Annexures R1, R2 AND R3 and the detailed averments made in the counter affidavit in the paragraph as detailed hereinabove.

4. In view of the above, it is an admitted position that nothing remains to be adjudicated in this OA and, therefore, the OA is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
