Lt Col (Retd) Bana Harendra is present in-person today in the Court. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the respondents that the only requirement in this case is the submission of an undertaking certificate duly signed by the applicant as per format given at page 22 of the OA, stating that he has not claimed and received any lump sum compensation in lieu of the disability as shown in RMB proceedings, the said certificate of the applicant be submitted through proper channel.

2. The disability of the applicant is aggravated by the military service as evident from RMB placed at page 99 of the counter affidavit. Further, the Government of India, Ministry of

Defence letter No. 16(5)/2008/D(Pen/Policy) dated 29.09.2009, provides that the Armed Forces personnel who are retained in service despite disability which is accepted as attributable to or aggravated by the military service and have forgone lump -sum compensation in lieu of the disability may be given disability element at the time of retirement/ discharge on or after 01.01.2006. The disability of the applicant is squarely covered by 'Guide to Medical Officers (Military Pensions), 2002.

3. Lt Col (Retd) Bana Harendra has submitted that he is ready to give the undertaking through proper channel and prays that the same be considered and the disability element of pension be granted to him.

4. In view of the statement made by applicant, the respondents are directed to consider the case of applicant and grant him the benefits subject to the approval of the Competent Authority.

5. Accordingly, this OA stands disposed off.
