3. Having made certain submissions on the merit of the matter, Mr. S.S. Pandey, learned counsel for the applicant raised a ground to say that the applicant has been discriminated against in the matter with regard to the incident in question for which the Court of Inquiry for short 'CoI' was conducted. Apart from the applicant, the main

person involved in the matter, Warrant Officer Mr. Dharmapal Kaushik, has been granted pensionary benefits. However, in the case of the applicant, he has been discriminated against and shortfall of less than 5 months to earn pensionary benefits has not been granted and he is thus deprived of the pension.

- 4. However, we find that no such specific averments have been made in the application. In case the applicant wants to make certain averments, he may do so on affidavit so that we can call upon the respondents to give their say in the matter and decide the issue of discrimination. A week's time is granted to Mr. S.S. Pandey, learned counsel for the applicant, to file an affidavit.
