## ORDER 19.12.2024

Respondents have been granted time not only to file the counter affidavit but also to file an additional affidavit and to show cause as to why the benefit of reservation as indicated in the order passed on 12.09.2024 should not be granted to the applicant. Neither the counter affidavit nor the additional affidavit has been filed in pursuance to the order passed on 12.09.2024.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant points out that the applicant is entitled to the reservation as stipulated in the advertisement issued by the Service Selection Board which indicated in the order passed on 12.09.2024 and he argues that the respondents have not filed the counter affidavit or additional affidavit and the discharge of the applicant should be stayed by an interim order. Learned counsel for the

respondents prays for two weeks' time to file the reply or at

least the additional affidavit in support of their contention

and we are informed that the applicant is to be discharged on

March, 2025. Therefore, as a matter of last indulgence, we

grant three weeks' time to the respondents to give their say

with regard to as to why the reservation cannot be granted to

the applicant failing which we shall grant an interim relief as

prayed for by the applicant.

3. List the matter again on **20.01.2025**.
