Issue notice to the original respondents in OA No.99/2022 asking them to show cause as to why contempt proceedings should not be initiated against them. They are granted four weeks' time to comply with the order and submit a report failing which coercive action for contempt should be initiated against them.

2. It is stated by learned counsel for the respondents that instructions have been received to challenge the order passed before the Hon'ble High Court. Merely, by taking a decision to challenge the order without actually filing the petition and obtaining appropriate orders from the Hon'ble High Court, this Court cannot grant any relief to the respondents in the matter of implementation of the execution of this order. Therefore, respondents are directed to implement the order

within four weeks failing which contempt action would be initiated against them.
