This is an application filed under Section 22(2) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007 seeking condonation of 8519 days delay in filing the present OA. In view of the judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the matter of **UoI & Ors Vs Tarsem Singh (2008) 8 SCC 648** and in **Ex Sep Chain Singh Vs Union of India & Ors, Civil Appeal 22965/2017** arising out of Civil Appeal Diary no 30073/2017 and the reasons mentioned, the MA 2917/2025 is allowed and the delay in filing the OA 2094/2025 is thus condoned. The MA 2917/2025 is disposed of accordingly.

The applicant vide the present OA makes the following prayers:-

*“(a) Direct the respondents to endorse the correct name as Urmila instead of Kumari Urmila and endorse the correct date of birth as 16.11.1964 instead of 31.07.1972 of applicant's wife in the Discharge Book and PFO in respect of DSC of the applicant.*

*“(b) Any other relief which the Hon'ble Tribunal may deem fit and proper in the fact and circumstances of the case along with cost of the application in favour of the applicant and against the respondents.”*

2. Notice thereof is issued and accepted on behalf of the respondents.
3. In view of documents that have been placed by the applicant, the short affidavit in response thereto be submitted by the respondents within a period of two weeks.
4. Re-list the matter on **21.08.2025**.
